// / Hake Brush

Great for gentle washes of color similar to a watercolor technique. Holds a lot of water

Mural Brush

Larger brush meant for big
surfaces

Round Brush
Great for making organic, varied strokes

My personal favorite, very versatile brush with a square tip

75 <u>Filbert Brush</u>

Very similar to a bright brush, but with a rounded tip

Short Handle

Best for small scale or very detailed work

Chip/Gesso Brush

A workhorse of a brush to cover a large surface quickly. Usually inexpensive

A small Chip Brush

A smaller version of the Chip
brush, can be used for
backgrounds


